These large-format touchscreen displays are a game changer for the classroom. You can think of it as a giant tablet computer with a touch screen and next generation software to access, manipulate, and interact with electronic files and the internet.

To boost Alief ISD's instruction, the leadership team had a strategic objective to implement IFPDs at the start of the school year, by August 1st, 2022.

ACTION AND RESULT

The contract awarded to Prime Systems included over 2200 Clear Touch® Interactive Flat-Panel Displays (IFPDs) to be delivered, connected, and up and working across 48 campuses, by August 1st, 2022. Working in partnership with the Alief ISD's technology services team, that's exactly what the Prime Systems team delivered. The team completed the implementation by the end of June, four weeks ahead of schedule.

We were able to deliver early due to intense coordination and teamwork. We developed backend processes that allowed the teams to prepare and configure the IFPD in groups of 100. We assembled the stands and modules at our facility to minimize campus disruption. When we delivered to the campus, every classroom need was considered in advance. We used quality assurance checklists to make sure all work was completed with perfection. We are so proud of our partnership with Alief ISD."
